

Refreshing, Revamping and Revitalising

Coca-Cola South Africa (CCSA) has assisted with the renovation to the Ngilonde (which means “keep safe” in Zulu) Community Care Centre in Chesterville, Durban. The facility, which was visited by the Worldwide PAC community after a meeting in Durban early last year, caters for approximately 230 orphaned and vulnerable children in the community and provides care and food on a daily basis.

The centre also runs a training programme for care-giver. CCSA ensured that proper toilets and bathrooms were built, encouraging sanitation and hygiene. The centre now houses a training room, a creche, a boardroom, a functional kitchen and a store room. Doors and locks were repaired and the offices for the administration staff were also given a face-lift. To stop off the refurbishing, the whole centre was given a fresh coat of paint. A grand opening will be taking place soon, where the new-look centre will be revealed.
